THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

- * Appearance
- Idiosyncrasies (Quirks)
- Personal History
- Interactions with Others
- Speech, thoughts, feelings, actions, and desires

APPEARANCE

- × Gender
- × Age
- × Disabilities
- Distinguishing marks
- Hair/eye colour
- Height/Weight
- × Clothing

- Do you, the narrator, give the description?
- Do you let other characters give the description?
- A combination of the two is better

IDIOSYNCRACIES (QUIRKS)

- Odd habits that help to define your character
- OCD (Monk)
- Stop smoking, start sucking on lollipops (Kojak)
- Can't seem to hold on to a job/keep money

A sucker for a pretty face...and other parts

PERSONAL HISTORY

- Get a feel for why a character does something (Batman, Spider-Man)
- Learn about past character interactions

Perfect for incorporating flashback

INTERACTIONS WITH OTHERS

Helps to define personality

- × Timid or rash
- × Courteous
- Male chauvinist
- × Feminist

- Does your character work well with others? A loner?
- How do other characters perceive your character?

SPEECH, THOUGHTS, FEELINGS, ACTIONS AND DESIRES

- Speech
 - + Educated vs. Street Smarts
 - + Dialect?
 - + Lots vs. Little talking
- Thoughts
 - + Do we hear his thoughts?
- Feelings
 - + Does she let feelings control self, or does she rely on reason?

- × Actions
 - + Choices make the character
 - + Positive vs. negative actions
- Desires
 - + What does your character want in life?
