

Fantasy Subgenres

HIGH FANTASY

 Typically set in an entirely fictional secondary world (not usually Earth) with detailed lore and a story of epic scope

LOW FANTASY

- Set in the "real" world or a rational fictional world that is similar to our own.
- Magical events "intrude on" a regular/non-magical world

DARK FANTASY

Has a noticeable horror element to the story.



Fantasy Subgenres

URBAN FANTASY

 Places fantastical elements (magic, mythical beasts, etc.) in modern, urban settings.

HEROIC FANTASY

- Stories that detail heroic battles between good and evil (or heroic character and their nemesis).
- Conflict tends to focus on hero's own personal grievance or vendetta rather than something affecting the entire world.

SCIENCE FANTASY

 Stories combine elements of science fiction and fantasy.
