Tools to use:

- Character Profile
- Setting Profile
- Any useful notes from class
- Your natural creativity/imagination

Requirements:

- Must use character from your profile as one of your characters
- Must use your setting profile in some manner
- Must include an identifiable protagonist and antagonist
- Must be able to identify type of conflict within story
- Characterization must be evident—the more subtle the better
- Must incorporate either foreshadowing or flashback
- Must be typed, 12-pt. font, double-spaced
- Title is mandatory. Should appear on a title page
- Story will be submitted on turnitin.com

Other Considerations:

Remember that you need to keep your story school appropriate. Emphasis on violence, profanity, and sexuality can lead to a forfeiture of credit.
